

How to handle limited profiles presented to you.

Some of you have many profiles to read. You can read them online, via your phone or computer or you can do it the old fashion way.

Today I am going to guide you towards a path that may work for you.

Print the profiles presented.

One: Read each one and make two piles “declined and potentials”. This, by itself, may take you a week or two to do. As you must pray about each profile and sincerely think it through.

Two: Set aside the declined pile and concentrate on the potentials pile. Once again, create two piles “declined and potentials”. This time you might have to talk about each profile with your team. You will have to pray again, and again. Read, and pray again.

Three: After a month or so of this you may find yourself with just two or three potentials. #1, #2, #3.

Four: Connect with these 3 individuals via the anonymous messaging system and find out if anyone of them would want to connect with you and start a conversation in earnest.

What I explained above is what I did with my daughter. When, I did this, I was using MatchBook because OMS did not have many BCs then. I copied and pasted to 20 separate word documents the profile of 20 gentlemen available according to her desired of age range. Then, I eliminated the pictures and all identifiers. Then, I gave her the 20 documents to read and pray about.

Within a week she eliminated 10 of them. Then she took over a month to select three people among the remaining 10. Today she is happily blessed with one of these three.

I am not saying this is the perfect formula, but I think it is not a bad way of doing it.
