Dear Everyone,

I hope all of you are doing well and now that the Holidays are behind us and a new year full of hope, expectations, and resolutions are ahead of us. It is my hope that we will see a great boom of first generation and Jacob children matched and blessed in the next twelve months.

The stats for the month of December reflect an average of 1 new registered person per day. As for the candidates ... we still have only ladies. I feel that it would be unwise to present them with only one gentleman candidate, so until such a time that I have three gentlemen candidates to activate all at once, I will wait a bit and hope we can get some men registered.

Why do we have to fill out an online application (such as OMS) and a paper application? This question has been asked of me several times and I would like to answer it here. OMS is simply a tool that can help candidates and MA to search for potential candidates. OMS does not yet replace the paper application that you must fill out. However, some information is similar and therefore an applicant should be able to copy and paste from OMS to paper application or vice versa quite easily.

Each country has their paperwork and requirements. Any candidates and MA from any country can use, and are encouraged to use, OMS to search for potential candidates. However, when it comes time to fill out the paperwork you will need to use the system that your own country has for matching/blessing candidates. There is no universal system yet.

If a candidate is located in a country that does not have an active Blessed Family Department, please contact a BFD from another country that can help you. Try to stay within your Region, but if that is not possible, please contact another active BFD. Many countries have good BFD departments (England, Canada, USA, Brazil, Japan, South Korea...)

What are Matching Advisors? I have been asked this question several times. Even though I have answered it and even posted an explanatory document on the "NEWS&DOCS" page of OMS, still many are confused since it is a unique concept. A Matching Advisor is a person who is willing to take responsibility for the matching and blessing of others. Matching Advisors are trusted and educated by the Blessed Family Departments to fulfill this responsibility. An MA is tasked to help you with paperwork. MAs also help determine if an applicant qualifies to become a candidate. That is very important. OMS will NOT overrule an MA's decision. In the USA, MAs works with BFD representatives. However, BFD reps are not necessarily MAs. Applicants should relate to an MA whom they trust and who knows them well. This is in order to get an approval to become a candidate on OMS.
